SNVC always encourages students' participation in competition for their holistic development.

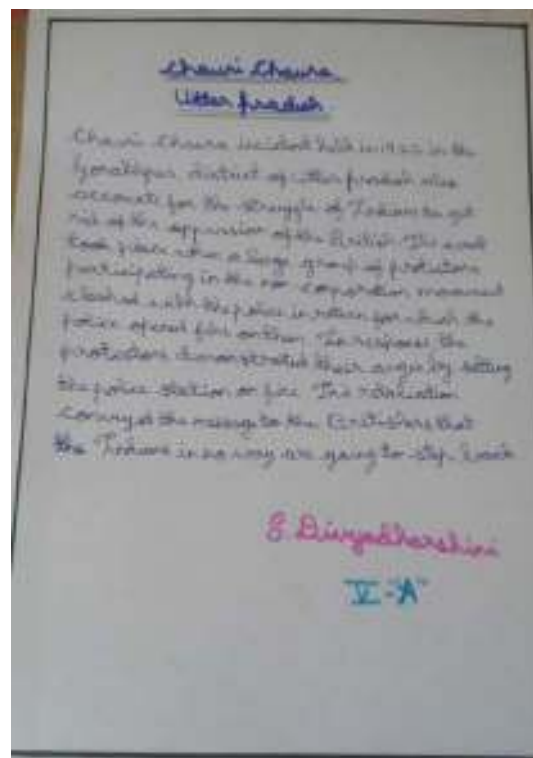
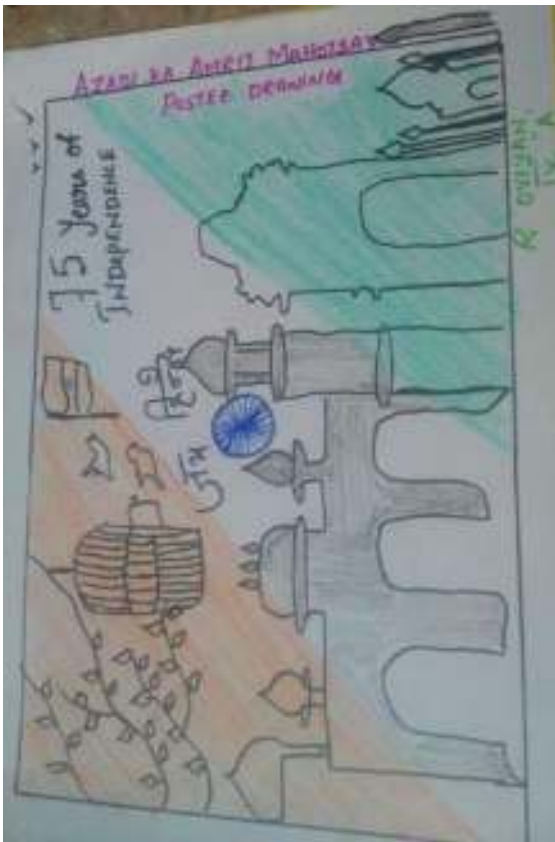

SwatchhBharath-HandWashing Activity

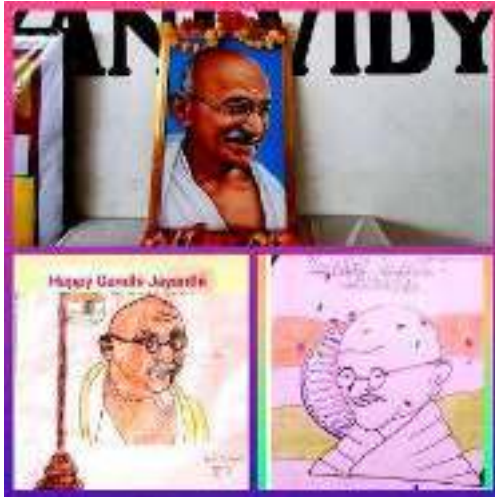
